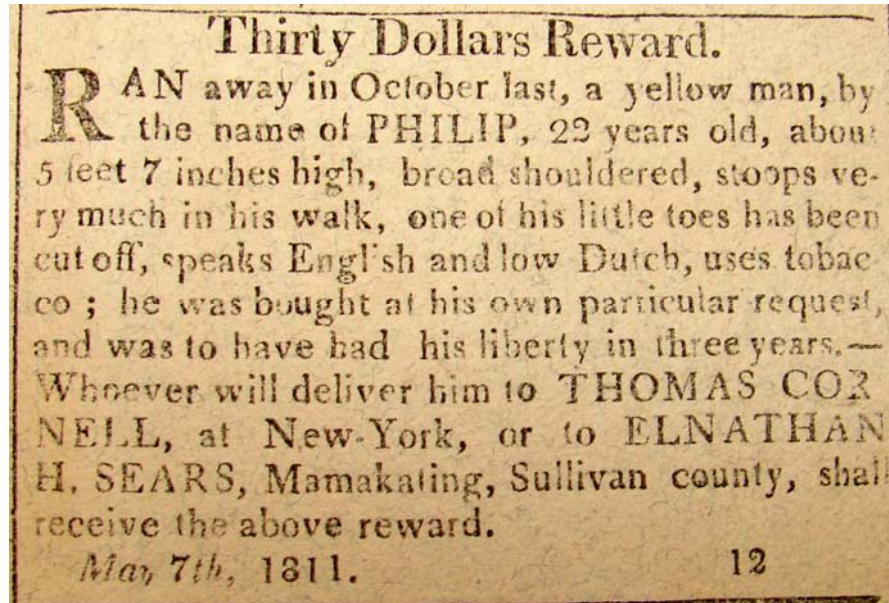


PHILIP OF SULIVAN COUNTY
